

How to apply for the Bachelor of Science in Psychology (Honours)

There are three ways to apply for the Bachelor of Science in Psychology (Honours):

- 1) Apply directly to University of Canberra online at www.canberra.edu.au/student-services/applying-to-study/home through the section on **Undergraduate Courses** → Non School Leavers: Apply Direct.
- 2) Apply directly to the University of Canberra via hardcopy application, using the form downloadable from www.canberra.edu.au/student-services/attachments/forms/direct-form.pdf
Note that you **do not** need to complete an Honours Supplement in addition to this form, despite this being requested on the form. For Psychology Honours we organise research topics and supervision after you have been accepted into the course.
- 3) Apply via the University Admissions Centre (www.uac.edu.au). The honours program is under the **Postgraduate Courses**, “Bachelor of Science in Psychology (Honours)”, with UAC Code 885716. Using the UAC method allows you to apply to different courses at different institutions.

Due date: Applicants who wish to have their applications considered in the First Round of Offers for Semester 1, 2012 should lodge their applications by 31st October 2011. Applications made after that date may still be processed subject to the availability of places.
